**Alphonse Mellot 2012 'Cuvee Edmond' Sancerre, France(6pk-750 ml)  
was 79.99, now 59.99**

"Aromas of limes, yellow citrus, crushed stones, herbs, chamomile and honey lead the 2012 Sancerre Edmond to a refreshingly mineral, profound and pure palate of great expression and a stimulating length with citrus flavors."

**Domaine Bonnet Huteau 2014 Muscadet Goulaine, France  
was 22.99, now 18.99**

A hint of honey in the fragrance, a cool climate freshness and quite aromatic for a Melon de Bourgogne. The palate is crispy, deep and mineral, an intense Muscadet, which is more suitable as a food companion, than as a soloist. Poultry or white meat with or without cream sauce are an ideal combination.

**Chateau Les Croisille 2014 Cahors Divin Croisille, France  
was 39.99, now 29.99**

"This wine is a selection from the three best parcels of the estate. As such, it is the quintessence of Malbec from the chalk soil of the plateau above Cahors. It is rich but even now still structured with firm tannins. Low yields and organically grown grapes give concentration and purity."

**Chateau de la Selve 2014 Serre de Berty, France  
was 28.99, now 19.99**

The Serre de Berty is a blend of 60% Syrah, 30% Merlot and 10% of Grenache and Cinsault. The vineyard lies 120 meters above sea level in a limestone and clay mix soil. It is aged in Burgundy barrels for 24 months.

The Serre de Berty is dark cherry in color with exceptional shine. A very complex nose with aromas of leather, blackcurrant and spice. It is a wine with beautiful structure, silky tannins and long finish. Best paired with roasted meats and mature cheeses.

**Gaujal de Saint Bon 2016 Picpoul de Pinet AOP, France  
was 13.99, now 8.99**

Domaine Gaujal St. Bon is a small estate-bottled operation run with extreme diligence by the mother-daughter team, Simonne and Virginie Gaujal. The wine is fresh, bright and full of energy with citrus flavors and a briny minerality that makes it the ideal match for shellfish, but also pairs well fish, chicken and light salads.

**Julien Sunier 2016 Beaujolais Regnie, France  
was 29.99, now 21.99**

If you have not tasted the wines of Julien Sunier, now is your chance. He is making some of the best Cru Beaujolais on the market, which arrives here in painfully small amounts every fall (50 cases of this made it to the western US).

**Domaine Jolivet 2016 Saint Joseph Blanc La Clef de Sol, France  
was 39.99, now 32.99**

The Jolivet wines have an impressive clarity and brilliance, powerful, but always vinified on perfectly ripened grapes and fine tannins, there is no heaviness due to over ripeness in the wines.

**Mas des Brousses 2013 Mas de Brousses AOC Coteaux Languedoc,  
France  
was 24.99, now 15.99**

Xavier Peyraud, grandson of Lulu Peyraud of the famed Domaine Tempier in Bandol, together with his wife Geraldine Combes, took over her family vineyards and achieved their shared dream of starting their own domain: Mas des Brousses.

**Ch. de Puligny-Montrachet 2011 NSG 1er 'Grandes Vignes, France  
was 89.99, now 59.99**

This bottling of "Clos des Grandes Vignes" Premier Cru Monopole comes from a 70-year-old vineyard of 1.2 hectares. "An intensely floral nose combines with notes of spicy green tea, anise, earth and a hint of the sauvage. There is a seductive, even silky mouth feel to the very supple, round and delicious flavors that are underpinned by dusty tannins on the well balanced and persistent finish. Lovely stuff fashioned in an understated style."

**Marco Cecchini 2011 Refosco DOC, Italy**

**was 28.99, now 19.99**

Floral, black fruits on the nose; medium to full-bodied, dry, fruity, plum and blackberry with lively acidity and a firm tannic finish and a floral note.

**Bodegas Frontonio 2015 Telescopico Blanco, Spain**

**was 22.99, now 13.99**

Dry, crisp acidity, integrated alcohol adding creamy texture. Medium body, very long, concentrated and intense profile.

**Bodegas Frontonio 2015 Telescopico Carinena, Spain**

**was 28.99, now 14.99**

The wine expresses red cherry and wild berries aromatics with black pepper, basil and smoked hints. It is crisp, vibrant and medium bodied with velvety tannins and intense red berries flavors with very fresh and spiced aftertaste. Smoked flavors from used barrels are really elegant and subtle.

**Hudson Wines 2016 White Study, Napa Valley, Carneros, California**

**was 39.99, now 29.99**

Light, bright and intense, "White Study" is a unique, tiny-production wine that Hudson Vineyards makes as much for their own pleasure as to sell.

**Selene 2014 Hyde Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, California**

**was 21.99, now 18.99**

Lemon curd, lightly caramelized meringue, and even a slight a hint of short crust pastry a la lemon meringue pie; beeswax, pear eau de vie, honeysuckle, and a slight star anise. Savory and mouthwatering, showing a little mineral character, finishing with long flavors that echo the aromatics.

**Flaneur Wines 2014 X-Novo Chardonnay, Eola-Amity Hills, Oregon**

**was 44.99, now 29.99**

Full-bodied and rich but with a nice tangy zip to balance it all out. A Flaneur is a man of leisure – someone who walks slowly, taking in life and their surroundings. The wines from Flaneur Winery might just inspire you to take life at this pace, even if just for a time. They are wines with more than meets the casual eye – deep, rich, layered and finely textured.
