Le Petit Haut-Lafitte Blanc Pessac-Leognan, 2018

Bordeaux, France. Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon. Offers up enticing aromas of green guava, fresh pineapples, ripe pears and passion fruit with lemongrass and chalk dust. The medium to full-bodied palate bursts with tropical fruit and fresh pear-inspired flavors with a satiny texture and just enough freshness, finishing with a spicy kick.

Ogier Viognier de Rosine, 2018

Rhône Valley, France. Vibrant, mineral-accented aromas and flavors of white peach and melon, with orange pith and floral elements gaining strength in the glass. Shows very sharp focus and a touch of ginger spice.

Domaine Cottenceau Montagny 1er Cru *Vignes Longues*, 2018

Burgundy, France. Mingles aromas of orange blossom and green orchard fruit with hints of warm pastry and toasted bread. Medium-bodied, racy and precise, it's lively and charming, concluding with a mineral finish.

- La Rioja, Spain. Intense, mineral-tinged red and blue fruit and floral scents are complemented by suggestions of baking spices, vanilla and woodsmoke. Supple, seamless and concentrated, yet lithe as well, offering intense raspberry, cherry-vanilla and rose pastille flavors underscored by vibrant mineral and blood orange nuances.

Antoniolo Gattinara Riserva, 2015

20 | 11 | 80

- Piedmont, Italy. "An absolutely gorgeous wine. Rose petal, sage, mint, sweet pipe tobacco, licorice and dried flowers lend striking aromatic nuance to a Gattinara that is endowed with tons of personality. Rich and pliant in the glass, it offers a striking interplay of rich fruit, bright acids and tannic spine. Marries finesse with power."

Martinelli Zinfandel *Giuseppe e Luisa*, 2018

26 | 14 | 104

- Russian River Valley, California. Medium ruby color and a nose of apricots, raspberry and strawberry, plus notes of black tea, blood orange and earth. Full-bodied, with a silky texture and nuanced flavor layers.

Vincent Paris Cornas *Granit 60*, 2019

30 | 16 | 120

- Rhône Valley, France. Spice- and mineral-tinged dark berries, potpourri, olive and a hint of smoky bacon on the highly perfumed nose. Juicy and focused offering densely packed blueberry, cherry liqueur, licorice and candied violet flavors supported by a spine of juicy acidity. Slowly mounting tannins add grip to an impressively persistent, finely etched finish that strongly repeats the floral note.
