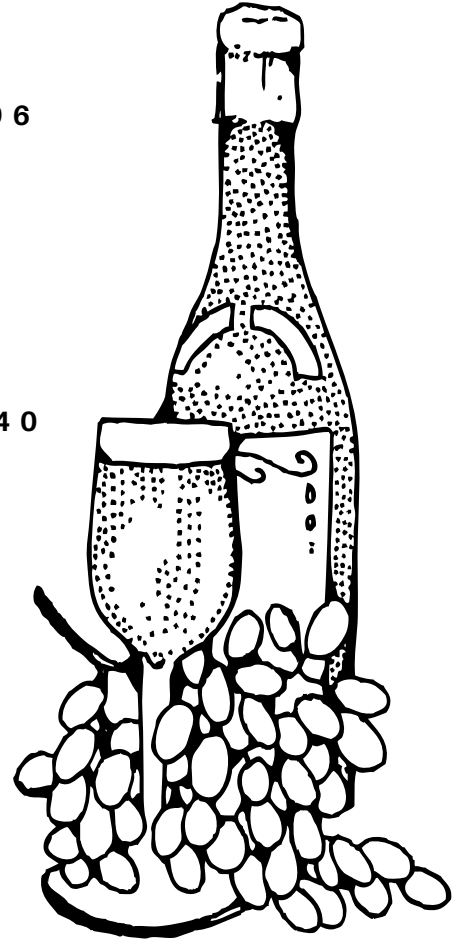

SOMMELIER SELECTION WHITES

2020 Spottswoode Sauvignon Blanc 24/13/96

Napa and Sonoma Valley, California.

Palest gold in color, this wine smells of green apple, gooseberries, and lemon cucumber. Crisp and lean and bright and beautifully textured.

2018 Chateau de Nalys Chateauneuf-du-Pape Blanc 55/28/220

Rhone Valley, France.

Beautiful notes of crushed rocks, honeysuckle, quince, and spice all flow to a medium to full-bodied, balanced, powerful white that's flawlessly balanced.

2015 Ancient Oaks Nurmi Chardonnay 28/15/112

Russian River Valley, California.

The palate has a gorgeously creamy structure with lots of stone fruit, citrus layers, and orange blossom. The nose has a honeysuckle scent with a long lingering finish.

2012 Joh.Jos. Prum Riesling Auslese 35/18/140

Zeltinger Sonnenuhr, Mosel, Germany.

Pristine apple, pear, and peach are marked with hints of nuts and crushed stones in this lusciously sweet auslese. Really starting to come to a great drinking age now. 7.5% ABV.

2018 Francois Gaunoux Meursault Clos de Tavaux Chardonnay 35/18/140

Burgundy, France.

100% Chardonnay. Representing a Domaine Monopole selection of vines, this wine shows the purity of Chardonnay. A rich crisp wine, with notes of apricot, pear, and a touch of almond.

2018 Laffourcade Savennieres Clos la Royaute Chenin Blanc 22/12/88

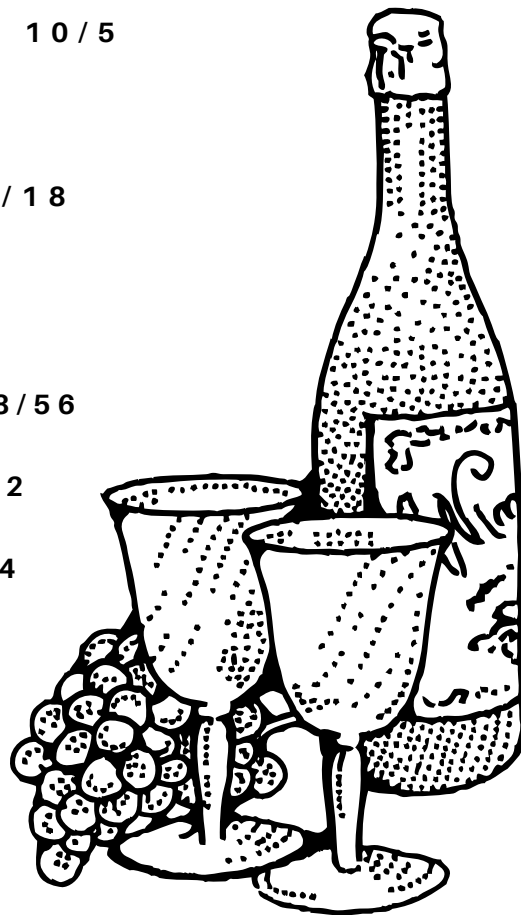
Loire Valley, France.

Beautiful notes of yellow apple, Asian pear, beeswax, and minerality on the palate. You'll get some lovely phenolic texture and weight, with a long, silky finish.

SOMMELIER SELECTION REDS

2018 Chateau Confidences de Prieure-Lichine 24/13/96*Margaux, Bordeaux, France.*

Round, forward, soft, lush, and polished in character, there is a sense of freshness that keeps the wine on its feet, allowing the black cherry, licorice, smoke, and espresso-filled wine to stand out in a crowd.

2016 Xavier Vignon Cuvee Anonyme Chateaunef-du-Pape 30/16/120*Rhone Valley, France.*

A dominant blend of Grenache and Mourvedre. Aromas of roses and purple cherries, as well as cassis, leading to a palate that delivers a very fresh, vibrant core of blue and purple berries.

2019 Daou Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 24/13/96*Paso Robles, California.*

Flavors of currant, boysenberry, and black plum accents of cigar box, crushed herbs, and pencil shavings. Firm, fine-grained tannins support a lengthy finish of sweet cherry, leather, toasty oak, and vanilla crème brûlée.

2017 Shea Wine Cellars Shea Vineyard Pinot Noir 25/13/100*Willamette Valley, Oregon.*

Unique terroir laced with volcanic and sandstone soils that give a unique black and red fruit combination. Extremely delicate, with an absolute sense of balance.

2008 R. Lopez de Heredia Rioja Reserva Viña Bosconia 25/13/100*La Rioja, Spain.*

Aromas of red berries, cherry cola, and candied rose, plus a smoky nuance. Finishes long and smooth, delivering a gentle tannic grip, and a snap of peppery spices.

2017 Produttori del Barbaresco 28/15/112*Piedmont, Italy*

The palate is ripe and pure, with raspberry leather, tea leaf, and blood orange. It is mouth-filling, with fruit that is long and persistent, fine tannins, and a lifted finish. Finessed and elegant.
