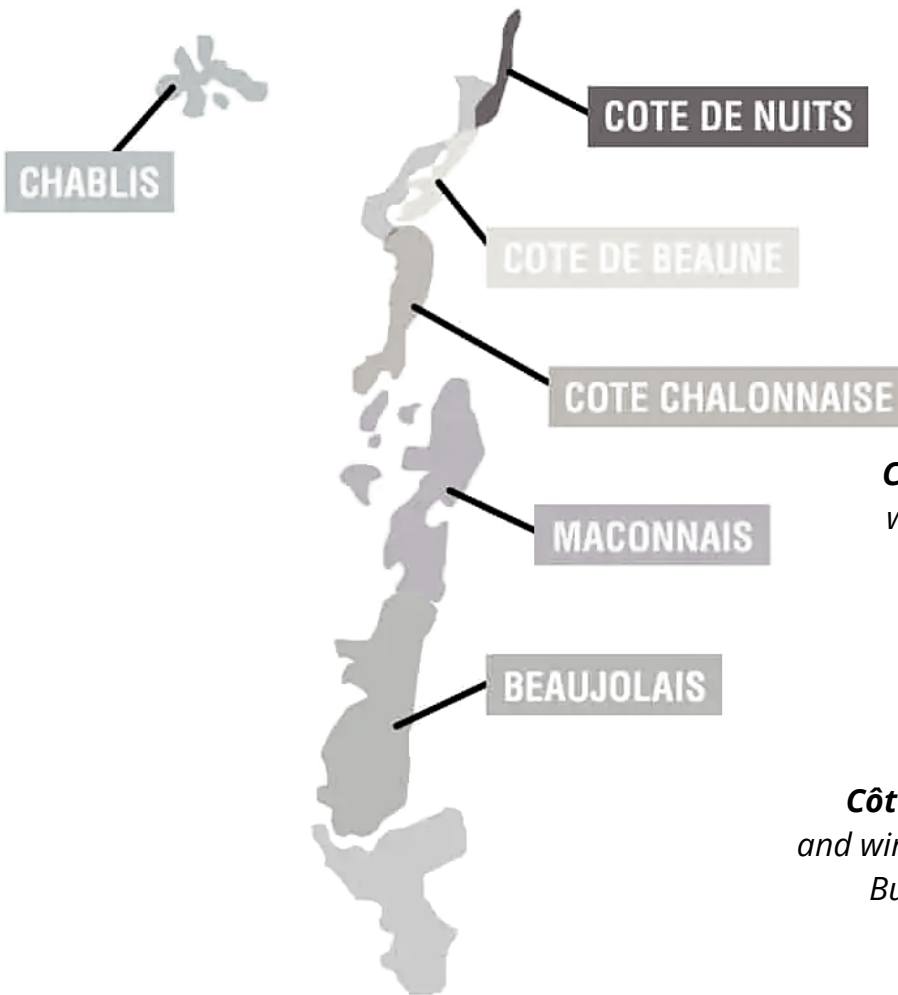

# Burgundy



**Chablis.** A Chardonnay-making wine region in the northwest corner of Burgundy, France. Unlike other Chardonnay wines, Chablis frequently does not use oak, resulting in a different style and taste profile. It's because of Chablis' renown that the unoaked Chardonnay style is popular worldwide.

**Côte de Nuits.** Mainly producing red wines, this wine-growing region is a paradise for Pinot Noir, which is used for the majority of the Bourgogne region's Grands Crus.

**Côte de Beaune.** Named after the important town and wine center of Beaune. The greatest white wines of Burgundy (and some high-quality reds) are grown on this stretch.

**Côte Chalonnaise.** Produces 70% red wines. These are generally very approachable in their youth also very affordable due to no grand cru vineyards.

**Maconnais.** A region in the South of Burgundy, named after the town of Macon. The area produces a considerable quantity of wine, specializing in white wines made from Chardonnay.

**Beaujolais.** An important region of eastern France, famous for its vibrant, fruity red wines made from Gamay. It is located in the southern part of Burgundy

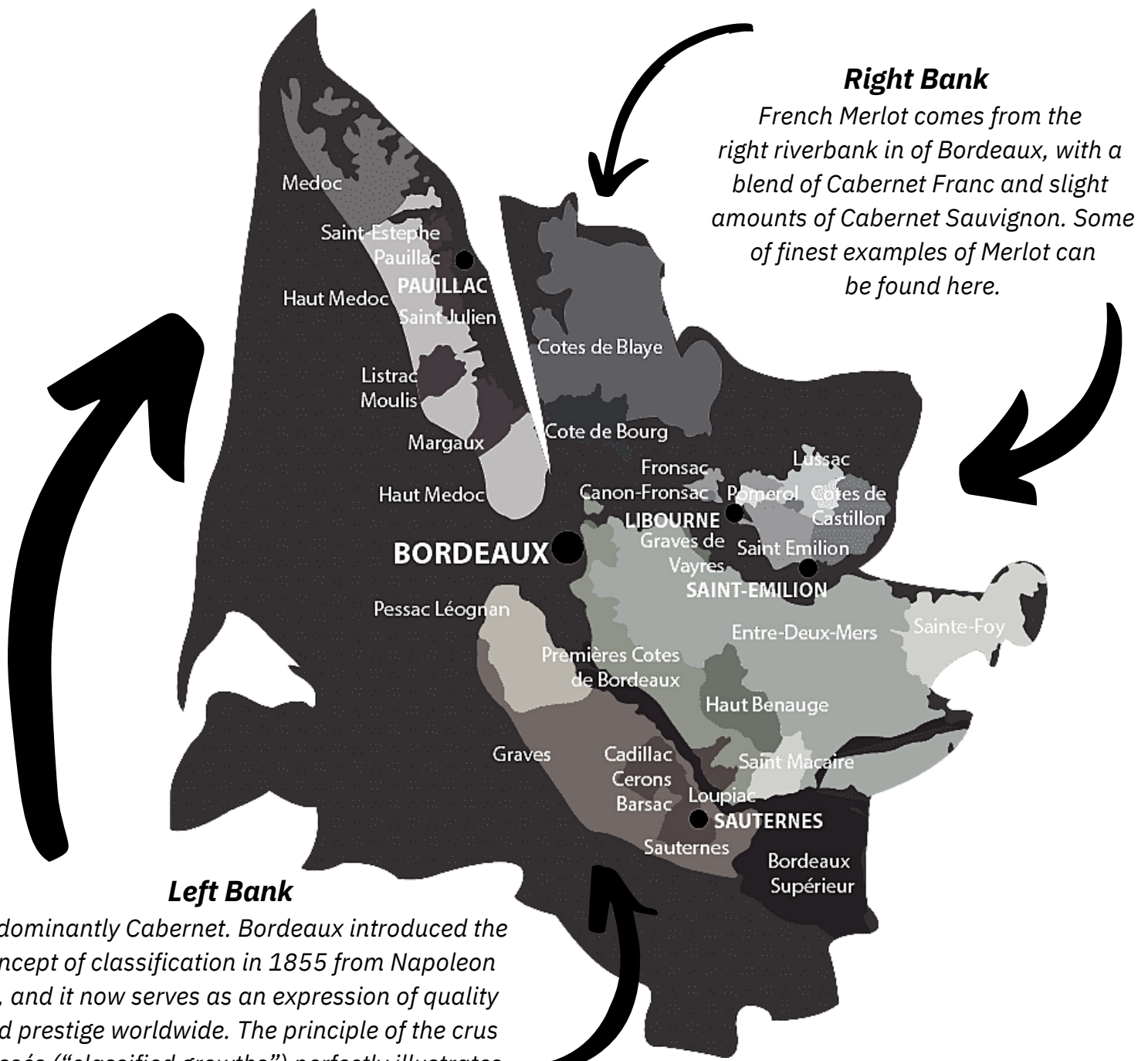

### **Right Bank**

*French Merlot comes from the right riverbank in of Bordeaux, with a blend of Cabernet Franc and slight amounts of Cabernet Sauvignon. Some of finest examples of Merlot can be found here.*

### **Left Bank**

*Predominantly Cabernet. Bordeaux introduced the concept of classification in 1855 from Napoleon III, and it now serves as an expression of quality and prestige worldwide. The principle of the crus classés (“classified growths”) perfectly illustrates the synthesis of a terroir’s typical characteristics and dedicated human intervention. They are ranked as PREMIERS CRUS (1st Growth), DEUXIÈMES CRUS (2nd Growth), TROISIÈMES CRUS (3rd Growth), QUATRIÈMES CRUS (4th Growth), and CINQUIÈMES CRUS (5th Growth). There are absolutely exceptions to qualities in this system.*
