SOMMELIER SELECTION WHITES

2020 Domaine Francois Villard Condrieu Les Terrasses du Palat 30/16/120
Rhône Valley, France

Juicy, ripe, and brimming with yellow apple, jasmine, white peach, and apricot notes, this pumps along nicely with an inner brightness showing through. Incredibly food-friendly wine.

2020 Leirana Albarino 20/11/80
Rias Baixas, Spain.

Pale, green-tinged yellow. Bright and sharply focused on the nose, displaying incisive Meyer lemon, honeysuckle, quinine, and mineral scents, along with a hint of ginger in the background.

2020 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 35/18/140
Napa Valley, California.

One of the most important Chardonnay's in the world, the very wine that defeated the French in the 1976 Judgment of Paris. Beautiful soft orange blossom, mouthwatering acidity, lush palate of Asian pear.

2020 Pierre Girardin Eclat de Calcaire Bourgogne Blanc Chardonnay 1.5 Liter 25/13/200
Burgundy, France.

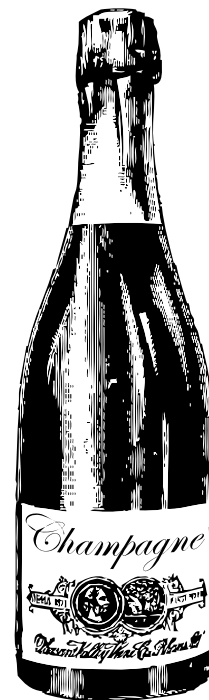
From two plots in Meursault and Volnay, this exceptional Blanc unwinds with white peach, wet limestone, and wildflowers. Amazing energy and density to its citrus flavors, finishing with a clean saline minerality.

2020 Te Mata Cape Crest Sauvignon Blanc 20/11/80
Hawkes Bay, New Zealand.

Luscious citrus and succulent stone fruit slide effortlessly towards a precise and lingering finish of gooseberry, lime, and sea salt. This blend contains 15% Semillon and Sauvignon Gris.

2014 Terre Rouge Roussanne Monarch Mine Vineyard 20/11/80
Sierra Foothills, California.

Roussanne's elusive aromas are resinous and honeyed with overtones of alpine wildflowers. The color is golden. Its flavors are dry, rich, expansive, and magnificent.

SOMMELIER SELECTION REDS

2019 Chateau Haut-Bailly II Pessac-Leognan Red Blend 30/16/120
Bordeaux, France.

The second wine of this incredible chateau in the Pessac-Léognan appellation, the 2019 Haut-Bailly II has a classic Graves scorched earth character as well as pure red and black fruits, tobacco, and cedary herb-like aromas and flavors. Round, plush, and sexy on the palate, it does everything you would want from a second wine

2018 Domaine Rostaing Les Lezardes Syrah 24/13/96
Rhône Valley, France

This cuvée has impressed the past couple of vintages. The 2018 Lezardes Syrah is fragrant and fruit driven, with attractive scents of raspberries, blackberries and licorice.

2019 Domaine Lucien Jacob Savigny-les-Beaune Rouge Pinot Noir 24/13/96
Burgundy, France.

Blackberry and blueberry jam, charred orange peel, sweet cherry, vanilla, and nutmeg. Very juicy with grippy, fine tannins.

2017 Macauley Vineyards Petite Sirah 40/21/160
Napa Valley, California.

The famed estate of Macauley produces an invoking Petite Sirah that over-delivers. Rich monstrous wine that carries serious weight on the back palate. Black currant, dried fruit, and intense spice. Decant if possible.

2016 Rocca di Montegrossi Chianti Classico Gran Selezione San Marcellino 32/17/128
Tuscany, Italy

Vigna San Marcellino is both youthfully fresh and maturely complex. It includes a healthy dose of the deeply colored Pugnitello grape, and both this and the Sangiovese saw long post-fermentation macerations of over 30 days in 2016. Liquorice, tarragon, and broom interlace with exuberant plum and understated toasted nuances that are seductive.

2018 Simi Landslide Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon 25/13/100
Alexander Valley, California.

Coming from the famous Landslide Vineyard, named after a Volcanic Landslide from the side of Mount St. Helena. Very fruit-forward showing cassis, red plum, blackberry, cocoa, vanilla, baking spice, bay leaves, and toasty notes with hints of cedar.

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
